Inserting & removing your hearing aids

1. Insert Batteries In Your Hearing Aids

- Open the battery compartment
- Insert a new battery
- "+" side facing up (flat side)
- Make sure the battery "+" and compartment "+" match.



2. Turn Your Hearing Aids On

- Close the battery door
- Your hearing aids may turn on immediately or your Hearing Professional may have programmed a 6,12, or 18 second start-up delay

3. Insert Your Hearing Aids

- A: Grasp receiver/dome between your thumb and forefinger
- Insert dome into your ear canal
- Gently work dome into proper position by slightly adjusting it until it is firmly seated in your ear
- B: Lift the hearing aid over the top of your ear
- Adjust it to fit behind your ear
- C: Press dome and receiver wire slightly for a secure and comfortable fit.
- Place retention strand into the bottom "bowl" of your ear (if applicable)

 - Increase/decrease volume
 - Change programs
 - Live Listen (turn your phone into a remote mic)
